

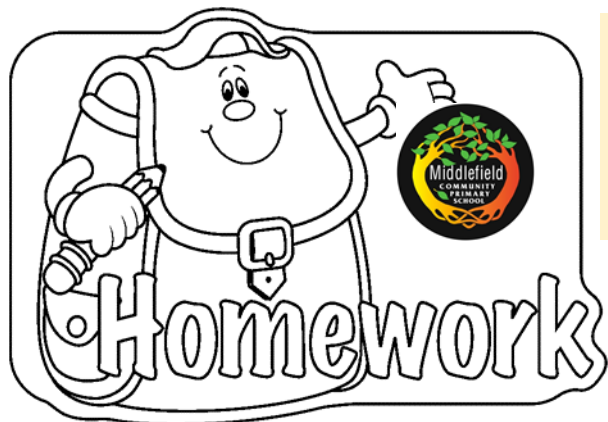


Autumn Term Creative Activity
