

Closure of Year 5

Dear Parent/Carer

As many of you will know, we had to close our Year 5 bubble this morning. This was because a child in Year 5 received a positive test. This means that anybody who had direct or close contact with that child now needs to self-isolate for 14 days from their last contact with that child. So this means that the Year 5 bubble will reopen on Wednesday 30th September.

The Year 5 classroom areas will now undergo a deep clean. There is no need for any further action for children or staff in any other bubble.

Only members of the Year 5 bubble are required to self-isolate. Siblings and the rest of the household are able to carry on with normal activities, provided that the child in Year 5 does not develop symptoms. If this happens, please inform school as soon as possible.

Please let me reassure you that we are following clear **national guidelines**, and that all of our decisions are made in line with Public Health England and Liverpool City Council procedures. The bubbles are in place to limit the potential impact of the virus.

Year 5 have been provided a clear set of work to complete and will have daily support and guidance from their teachers online.
