Dear Parent/Carer

As you know, unfortunately your child is required to self-isolate and cannot return to school until Friday 6th November. This sadly means that your child will miss 4 days of school.

However, we will be providing online and distance learning to try to lessen the impact upon your child's learning. On Monday 2nd November, staff will deliver home-learning packs to your address. These contain work books, whiteboards, paper, stationery etc.

We will also deliver devices to those parents who completed the recent survey of IT needs and indicated that they needed to borrow a laptop/tablet. These need to be returned on Friday 6th.

The work packs contain Maths, Phonics and Comprehension books and your child should complete one of each of these activities each day.

Beginning on Tuesday, a teacher will host 2 live lessons each day- English and Maths, via Google Meet. You will need a gmail or goglemail account to access these.

The codes required to join the sessions will be text to you by Monday.

In addition, work will be set daily on MyMaths, TT Rockstars and Oxford Reading Owl. Your child has passwords for these.

School will also provide shopping vouchers for those children who are in receipt of Income Based Free School Meals, whilst your child is absent.
