Good news! Further to my letter of 21st March, I am very pleased to inform you that Year 1 will reopen to all children tomorrow.

A member of the Year 1 bubble had tested positive on a home Lateral Flow Test on Sunday. As a result, we wrote to you to ask contacts to isolate in line with national guidance.

Following advice, they subsequently took a confirmatory PCR test and that test returned a negative result.

As a result of the negative confirmatory PCR test, the precaution taken to close Year 1 can now be lifted and it is safe for all children to attend on Tuesday 23rd March.

We have continued to follow local and national guidelines at all times and the decisions both to close and to reopen have been made in line with Liverpool City Council and Public Health England advice.

We look forward to seeing all children again tomorrow.
