



## Nursery Session Times

Dear Parent/Carer

Thank you for your patience and understanding this term as we have all adjusted to the many new routines and rules in place.

I can now confirm that we will be returning to two daily sessions in Nursery, beginning on **1<sup>st</sup> February**. This means that morning nursery will once again be **8:30am-11:30am** and afternoon nursery times are **12:15pm-3:15pm**.

As you will be aware, attendance in Reception to Year 6 is limited to the children of critical workers and vulnerable children only. The DfE have determined that Nursery classes are open to **all** children. Some parents have decided not to return their children to Nursery this term. Nursery is non-statutory and parents are still able to make this decision if they have any concerns or worries.

Having the children split over two sessions ensures lower numbers and better ratios. It will also enable children who are due to start nursery this term to do so.

So from Monday 1<sup>st</sup> February, children should return to their usual morning or afternoon session.
