



## Closure of Year 1

Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> December 2020

Dear Parent/Carer

I am sorry to inform you that we have had to close the Year 1 Bubble. This is because a member of that bubble has received a positive test. This means that anybody who has had direct or close contact with that person, now needs to self-isolate for 10 days from their last contact. So this means that Year 1 will be closed for the rest of the term.

The Year 1 classroom areas will now undergo a deep clean. There is no need for any further action for children in any other bubble.

Only members of Year 1 are required to self-isolate. Siblings and the rest of the household are able to carry on with normal activities, provided that the child from Year 1 does not develop symptoms. If this happens, please inform school as soon as possible.

Please let me reassure you that we are following clear **national guidelines**, and that all of our decisions are made in line with Public Health England and Liverpool City Council procedures. The bubbles are in place to limit the potential impact of the virus.

Year 1 will now be provided a clear set of work to complete and will have daily support and guidance from their teachers online.
